

## Summary of facilitators observations

Your participation in the online for a has been commendable throughout the duration of the course. Your rich field experience if finely narrated in response to the questions and exercises proposed throughout this course, and you clearly listen to and engage with other participants on the course. This was evinced in the musem visit (with Berit, Emily and Eva), the focus group (Virginia, Rocio, Emily and Pio) and the elicitation activity (with Elettra). Overall, a big well done on collaboration, you evince a sustained practice in this key open attitude. Excellent.

Assignment One, looking at peasant movements in India, is a well narrated and projected research concept. In your revision of this assignment in 4.8, you gave more weight to the role of NGO's in your research and your alliance to them. In your revision, further thought is also given to women in the shadows, considering their specific roles as well as affirming your own purpose. You also include means to achieving informed consent in practice. These responses to feedback provided by Elizabeth was well evaluated by the course tutors.

Assignment two, highlighting method choice as context-dependant, and well identifying key features and characteristics of participant-observation, diary keeping and interviews, offered a high-quality reflection. You made spot-on comments on "piercing" data though note-taking, and several other insightful reflections which Alejandro commented on in detail.
